 lands lying in the city of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: The South Fifty (50) feet
of Lot Five in Block One hundred and twenty nine (129). More
particularly described as a plat of land fifty by one hundred and
forty feet having a frontage of fifty feet on Houston Avenue and a
depth of one hundred and forty feet to alley and adjoining
Lot Four with a uniform width of fifty feet. In the City
of Tulsa Indian Territory. According to government plat
To have and to hold the same unto the said H. B. Rawlings and unto his heirs and as-

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
