WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Emmily D. Widmer and W. B. Widmer her husband
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty-nine Hundred and No/100 DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said A. B. Jordan and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Five (5) in Block Six (6) in the Friend and
Gillite addition to the City of Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said A. B. Jordan and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said A. B. Jordan that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, W. B. Widmer husband of the said Emmily D. Widmer for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said A. B. Jordan all rights of country dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
