WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, E. E. Wright and Minnie B. Wright
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Two Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,
cash in hand the Receipt is hereby Acknowledged
 do hereby grant,

bargain, sell and convey unto said W. M. Collins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Eleven (11) in Block Three (3) in Turkey
Addition to the City of Tulsa Western District
Indian Territory according to the Recorded
Plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said W. M. Collins and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said W. M. Collins that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie B. Wright, wife of the said E. E. Wright for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said W. M. Collins all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
