## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, George West and Lizzie West  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred + 00/100 DOLLARS,  
in hand paid by William Collins, the receipt  
of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said William Collins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Eight (8) in Block Four (4) in Turkey's Addition  
to the town of Tulsa

To have and to hold the same unto the said William Collins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said William Collins that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie West, wife of the said George West for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said William Collins all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
