WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, Lon R. Stansbury + Myrtle C. Stansbury +
John N. Day and Ratherine M. Day
 their wives
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen Hundred and 00/100 DOLLARS,

The receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
 and to us in hand paid by Orvin E. Long do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Orvin E. Long and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Stansbury Addition to Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Three (3) and Four (4), Block Two (2), and according
to the "Recorded Plat" of the said "Stansbury Addition"
to Tulsa land, Lu.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Orvin E. Long and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Orvin E. Long that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And we, Myrtle C. Stansbury wife of the said Lon R. Stansbury for and in consideration of the said sum of
Ratherine M. Day wife of the said John N. Day money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Orvin E. Long all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
