## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Harriett M. Morris and Sylvester Morris husband  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirteen hundred Forty DOLLARS,  
 in hand paid by Annie L. French the receipt  
 of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Annie L. French and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
South half of lot one and all of lot two in Block  
Ten in the City of Tulsa Indian Territory according  
to the official survey and plat

To have and to hold the same unto the said Annie L. French and unto her heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Annie L. French that I will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sylvester Morris husband Harriett M. Morris for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Annie L. French all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
