WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Harriett W. Morris and Sylvester Morris
~~her husband~~
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred DOLLARS,
 in hand paid by John S. French the receipt
 of which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said John S. French and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Osage Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
the North Half of Lot One in Block Ten in
the City of Tulsa Indian Territory according to
the Official Survey and plat

To have and to hold the same unto the said John S. French and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant, with said John S. French that el will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Sylvester Morris husband Harriett W. Morris for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said John S. French all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
