WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, L. H. Cone and Edith M. Cone
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Seven Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Clara E. McCullough and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of Lot numbered Four (4) in Block numbered
One (1) of the Friend Addition to Tulsa, Indian
Territory

To have and to hold the same unto the said Clara E. McCullough and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Clara E. McCullough that they will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Edith M. Cone, wife of the said L. H. Cone for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Clara E. McCullough all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
