## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Ralsa F. Morley and Augusta M. Morley X  
L.C. Mills his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty two Hundred fifty DOLLARS,  
Receipts of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Eugene L. & Marquette A. Freeman and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of the north half of Lot Six (6) in Block  
one hundred & ninety six (96) the same  
being 50 feet wide of each width and One hundred  
& forty feet deep original town of Tulsa Indian  
Country.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Eugene L. Freeman X Marquette A. Freeman and unto their heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said L.C. Mills X Ralsa F. Morley that they will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever. excepting one mortgage with the Interstate  
Mortgage Trust Co. of Person Name of \$12,000 dated January 9, 1907

And I, Augusta M. Morley, wife of the said Ralsa F. Morley for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Eugene L. & Marquette A. Freeman all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
