## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, George M. Litson and a single man  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Six Hundred Dollars in hand paid, DOLLARS;  
by J. Slater Davidson, the receipt whereof is hereby  
acknowledged and confessed, do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said J. Slater Davidson and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lots numbered Twenty-three (23), Twenty-four (24),  
Twenty-five (25), Twenty-six (26), and Twenty-seven (27) in Block One in the Oklahoma addition to the  
Town of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the  
recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said J. Slater Davidson and unto his heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant S. with said J. Slater Davidson that he will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, wife of the said for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said J. Slater Davidson all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
