WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Thomas F. M. Laughlin and single man
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred & fifty DOLLARS,

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Harry Gilbert and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The south one half (1/2) of Lot eight (8) in Block
nine (9) of the City of Tulsa Indian Ter. Original
Townsite as shown by the Government plat

To have and to hold the same unto the said Harry Gilbert and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Harry Gilbert that I will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, single man, wife of the said single man for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Harry Gilbert all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
