

## WARRANTY DEED With Relinquishment of Dower.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Jennie Cornsick and Jesse Goback and Jesse Goback Citizens of the Cherokee Nation and sole heirs to the estate of George Goback deceased his wife, of Stellwell Cherokee Nation Indian Territory

for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Hundred (\$2000) DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by Robert Pollock

of Piquette Indian Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Robert Pollock

and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit:

The E 1/2 of NW 1/4 of Sec 14, Twp 21 N. Range 14 East 5 acres  
and NE 1/4 of NW 1/4 of NW 1/4 of Sec 27, Twp 19 N. Range 14 East 10 acres  
Sec 27 Twp 21 N. Range 14 East - acres  
Sec 27 Twp 21 N. Range 14 East - acres

together and entire with all privileges, appurtenances and improvements thereon situate, appertaining and thereunto belonging.

To Have and to Hold the above described premises unto the said Robert Pollock and his heirs and assigns forever. And we the said Jennie Cornsick, Jesse Goback and Jesse Goback

Robert Pollock and his heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said Robert Pollock and his

heirs and assigns, that we are lawfully seized in fee simple of the above granted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that we have a good right to sell and convey the same as herein above; that we our heirs, executors and administrators shall, for ever warrant and defend the same to the quiet and peaceable enjoyment of said Robert Pollock and his heirs and assigns against all lawful claims and demands of all persons who shall claim.

And I, the grantor herein, do hereby join in this conveyance, and for the consideration aforesaid, convey and renounce all rights of dower and homestead in and to said property; and for the consideration aforesaid do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert Pollock and his heirs and assigns, all right, claim and possibility of dower and homestead in and to said property.
