

WARRANTY DEED With Relinquishment of Dower.

and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory to-wit: lands lying in the town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: Lot numbered three in block numbered three in Block Addition to Tulsa according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Frank Shreeb and unto his heirs and assigns forever

with all all privileges, appurtenances and improvements thereupon situate, appertaining, and thereunto belonging, and and hereby covenant with said Frank Shreeb that they ~~To Have and to Hold~~ the same unto the said will forever warrant and defend and all claims whatever. And the said the title of said lands against heirs and assigns forever. for set heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said

heirs and assigns, that lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that have a good right to sell and convey the same as herein done; that will, and heirs, executors and administrators shall, forever warrant and defend the same to the quiet and peaceable enjoyment of said

heirs and assigns against all lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

And I, Margaret Hagler wife of J. D. Hagler the grantor herein do hereby join in this conveyance, and for the consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the aforesaid, convey and renounce all rights of dower and homestead in and to said property; and for the consideration aforesaid do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Frank Shreeb heirs and assigns, all my right, claim and possibility of dower and homestead in and to said property. lands
