## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Martha Naharky and deceased One Thousand DOLLARS,  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand  
to her in hand paid by Ethel Davis and Hugh  
Gregg the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Ethel Davis and Hugh Gregg do hereby grant,  
 and unto their heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:  
The east half (1/2) of the east half (1/2) of the south  
west quarter (1/4) and the west half (1/2) of the  
west half (1/2) of the south east quarter (1/4)  
of section twenty six (26) Township nineteen (19)  
Range twelve (12), east in the Creek Nation  
Indian Territory containing 6 acres more or less  
 To have and to hold the same unto the said Ethel Davis and Hugh Gregg and their heirs and as-

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant do with said Ethel Davis and Hugh Davis that she will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha Naharky wife of the said Martha Naharky for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ethel Davis and Hugh Davis all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
