

WARRANTY DEED With Relinquishment of Dower.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS:

That we, Sam Company a single man of Red Fork Indian Territory

and his wife of

for and in consideration of the sum of Five thousand and no DOLLARS, to us in hand paid by James E. Whitehead of M^cAlister Indian Territory

the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained and sold, and by these presents, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said James E. Whitehead

and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate situated in the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory to-wit: The north half of the north-east quarter of section twenty-two and the east half of the north east quarter of section thirty-one (31) all in Township nine (9) North Range twelve (12) East in the Creek Nation of the Indian Territory

with all privileges, appurtenances and improvements thereupon situate, appertaining and thereunto belonging.

To Have and to Hold unto the said James E. Whitehead and his heirs and assigns forever. And I, the said Sam Company for myself my heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with the said James E. Whitehead

heirs and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee simple of the aforegranted premises; that they are free from all incumbrances; that I have a good right to sell and convey the same as herein done; that I will, and my heirs, executors and administrators shall, forever warrant and defend the same to the quiet and peaceable enjoyment of said James E. Whitehead heirs and assigns against all lawful claims and demands of all persons whomsoever.

And I, the grantor herein, do hereby join in this conveyance, and for the consideration aforesaid, convey and renounce all rights of dower and homestead in and to said property; and for the consideration aforesaid do hereby release and relinquish unto the said heirs and assigns, all right, claim and possibility of dower and homestead in and to said property.
