WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, S. Frank Jones and Minnie Jones
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Hundred & Fifty DOLLARS,
the receipt of the same being hereby acknowledged
and to us paid by Mattie M. Calhoun do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Mattie M. Calhoun and unto ... heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The north half of Lot five & Block one hundred
fifty (50) and according to the official plat and
Government Survey of the said City of Tulsa (D. I.)
City

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mattie M. Calhoun and unto her heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mattie M. Calhoun that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Minnie Jones wife of the said S. Frank Jones for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mattie M. Calhoun all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
