WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Thomas Wiswall and Aileen Wiswall
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty Six Hundred DOLLARS,
In hand paid by Mary E. Green, receipt of which
is hereby acknowledged and confessed do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Mary E. Green and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit: South half of Lot
three, Block One Hundred and One (141) being left of
fronting One hundred and forty feet deep in the
city of Tulsa Indian Territory according to the
recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Mary E. Green and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Mary E. Green that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Aileen Wiswall wife of the said Thomas Wiswall for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Mary E. Green all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
