WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we R. E. Wymon single and unmarried of Pawhuska
Oklahoma Territory his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred and Eight DOLLARS,
to one in hand paid by Louisa Vann of the
City of Tulsa Indian Territory do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Louisa Vann and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the City of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of Lot numbered Six (6) in Block numbered
One Hundred and Seventy-nine (179) in the City
of Tulsa Indian Territory, according to the
official plat and Government Survey of said City of
Tulsa said lot being 50 feet by 140 feet

To have and to hold the same unto the said Louisa Vann and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Louisa Vann that he will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Louisa Vann, wife of the said R. E. Wymon for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said R. E. Wymon all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
