# WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred DOLLARS,  
to them in hand paid by Elizabeth K. Ryan the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Elizabeth K. Ryan and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot six in Block Two of the George B  
Permyan Addition to Tulsa Indian Territory  
according to the recorded plat thereof

To have and to hold the same unto the said Elizabeth K. Ryan and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Elizabeth K. Ryan that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell wife of the said W. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Elizabeth K. Ryan all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
