WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS,

That we, Thomas F. McLaughlin, and a single and unmarried man
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Five Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,
the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged

do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Harry Gilbert and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Western Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

The south one-half (1/2) of Lot eight (8) in Block
nine (9) in the City of Tulsa Western District Indian
Territory according to the Government Survey and
plat thereof. This deed is made to cure defect in a deed
between the same parties to the above described plat of lot and
dated May 18 25 1907 and filed for record at Tulsa, Okla. May 22 1907
To have and to hold the same unto the said Harry Gilbert and unto his heirs and as

signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Harry Gilbert that I will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Thomas F. McLaughlin, wife of the said Harry Gilbert for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Harry Gilbert all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
