his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of \$2,750.00 The Hundred Seventy five DOLLARS,the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged
do hereby grant,bargain, sell and convey unto said Floyd Corlett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:all of Lot 4 in Block 6 in the Stansbury
Addition to the City of Tulsa, OK according
to the recorded plat of said additionTo have and to hold the same unto the said Floyd Corlett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.And hereby covenant S. with said Floyd Corlett that they will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.And I, Myrtle C. Stansbury Joseph R. Stansbury
wife of the said John N. Day for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Floyd Corlett all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.Witness our hands and seals on this 16th day of May, 1907
