WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, John H. Oliphant and Martha S. Oliphant
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Twenty-five DOLLARS,
in hand paid by Roy C. Corlett the receipt of
which is hereby acknowledged do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said Roy C. Corlett and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot five (5) in Block One (1) in the Bellevue
addition to the town of Chelsea

To have and to hold the same unto the said Roy C. Corlett and unto his heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Roy C. Corlett that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Martha S. Oliphant wife of the said John H. Oliphant for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Roy C. Corlett all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
