WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we W. E. Campbell and Emily M. Campbell
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight hundred \$1600.00 DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by Henry Brandner of
Benkelman County Nebraska the receipt of which is
hereby acknowledged Henry Brandner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following

lands lying in the Creek Nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

all of lots eight (8) and nine (9) in Block one (1)
in the George B. Poppman Addition to the City of
Chulsa in said Nation District and Territory and
as shown by the plat on record of said addition

To have and to hold the same unto the said Henry Brandner and unto his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Henry Brandner that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Emily M. Campbell, wife of the said W. E. Campbell for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Henry Brandner all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
