WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we William L. Gilcrease and Lizzie Gilcrease
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred and no DOLLARS,
to us in hand paid by Robert Randolph
Wialaka IT do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said Robert Randolph and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Creek nation Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:
Lots (one) (two) (three) (four) (five) and (six) in Block
(30) thirty in the town of Wialaka according to
plat filed in the 28 recording District at
Tulsa Ind Terr.

To have and to hold the same unto the said Robert Randolph and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.
And hereby covenant with said Robert Randolph that we will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Lizzie Gilcrease, wife of the said William L. Gilcrease for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Robert Randolph all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
