WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Percy Collins and Helena B. Collins
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eleven Hundred and Fifty DOLLARS,
to them in hand paid by F. G. Rodolf, the receipt
whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged do hereby grant,
bargain, sell and convey unto said F. G. Rodolf and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following
lands lying in the Town of Tulsa Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

Lot Numbered Two in Block Numbered Five
in the Friend & Gillette Addition to Tulsa, C.T.,
according to the recorded plat thereof.

To have and to hold the same unto the said F. G. Rodolf and unto his heirs and as-
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said F. G. Rodolf that they will forever warrant and defend the
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Helena B. Collins, wife of the said Percy Collins for and in consideration of the said sum of
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said F. G. Rodolf all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
