WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we, S. K. Williams and Bessie L. Williams,
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Nineteen — 5/00 DOLLARS,
to us paid by M. T. Matthews, do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said M. T. Matthews and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the $\frac{1}{4}$ of the $\frac{1}{4}$ and the West half (shown on the U. S.
 survey as lot 42) of the $\frac{1}{4}$ of sec 31, T 19 N and Range
 14 E, Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory,
 to-wit:
Lot 11 No. Eleven blocks 18 Mo. Eighteen
in Valley et. I.

To have and to hold the same unto the said M. T. Matthews and unto her heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said M. T. Matthews that we will forever warrant and defend the title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. K. Williams, for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M. T. Matthews all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
