WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. H. Williams and Bessie L. Williams
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve — 50/100 DOLLARS,
to us paid by M. F. Matthews

do hereby grant,
 bargain, sell and convey unto said M. F. Matthews and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following
 lands lying in the N.E. 1/4 of the N.W. 1/4 and the West half (shown on the U.S.
Survey as lots (12) of the N.W. 1/4 of Sec 31, T19N and Range
14E, Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory,
to-wit:
Lot 11 No. Eleven Block 18 No. Eighteen
in Valley el. T.

To have and to hold the same unto the said M. F. Matthews and unto her heirs and as-
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant we with said M. F. Matthews that we will forever warrant and defend the
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. H. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said M. F. Matthews all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
