## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we S. H. Williams and Bessie L. Williams  
 his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Twelve — 3/100 DOLLARS,  
to us paid by E. D. Barkins

do hereby grant,  
 bargain, sell and convey unto said E. D. Barkins and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following  
 lands lying in the N. E. 1/4 of the NW 1/4 and the West half (shown on the U. S.  
survey as lot 42) of the NW 1/4 of Sec. 31 T19 N and Range 14 E,  
Leah Nation, Western District of the Indian  
Territory, to-wit:  
Lot 6 No. six Block 29 No. Twenty nine  
in Valley 17

To have and to hold the same unto the said E. D. Barkins and unto his heirs and as-  
 signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant we with said E. D. Barkins that we will forever warrant and defend the  
 title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Bessie L. Williams, wife of the said S. H. Williams for and in consideration of the said sum of  
 money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said E. D. Barkins all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
