## WARRANTY DEED

WITH RELINQUISHMENT OF DOWER.

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS.

That we Mary J. Allen and a single woman  
his wife, for and in consideration of the sum of Eight Hundred DOLLARS,  
to me paid by Ella Gravitt

do hereby grant,  
bargain, sell and convey unto said Ella Gravitt and unto her heirs and assigns forever, the following  
lands lying in the twenty eighth Western District of the Indian Territory, to wit:

South-east quarter of the south-west quarter  
and the south-east quarter of the north-east quarter  
of the south-west quarter Section thirty (30)  
Township twenty (20) N. Range fourteen (14) east

To have and to hold the same unto the said Ella Gravitt and unto her heirs and as-  
signs forever, with all appurtenances thereunto belonging.

And hereby covenant with said Ella Gravitt that I will forever warrant and defend the  
title of said lands against all claims whatever.

And I, Mary J. Allen, wife of the said Ella Gravitt for and in consideration of the said sum of  
money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said Ella Gravitt all rights of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.
