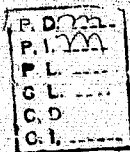

Know all Men By These Presents:

That We, Frank C. Hailey and Etta Hailey his wife and Amos Drew of Creek Nation, Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One \$ 100.00 Dollars, to them paid by Fred Bueky receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Fred Bueky his heirs and assigns forever the following described lot or parcel of ground, lying and being and situate in the Creek Nation, Western District of the Indian Territory, to-wit: The south west quarter of section Twenty in Township eighteen north and range fourteen east of the Indian Base and Meridian in Indian Territory containing one Hundred sixty acres more or less. To have and to hold the same unto the said Fred Bueky his heirs and assigns forever, with all appurtenances thereto belonging. And we Frank C. Hailey and Etta Hailey and Amos Drew hereby covenants with the said Fred Bueky that said lands are free from incumbrances, that we will forever quit claim the title to said lands against all lawful claims whatever.

And I Etta Hailey, wife of the said Frank C. Hailey for and in consideration of said sum of money, do hereby release unto the said Fred Bueky all my right of dower and Homestead in and to said lands.
