Personally appeared before me B. F. Pittus, a Notary Public in and for said District Indian Territory, Henry W. B. Perryman, who being first duly sworn deposes and says: That a patent of lot three (3) in block one hundred and eighty nine (189) in the City of Tulsa, was issued to him by P. Porter, principal chief of the Muskogee or Creek Nation on the twenty sixth day of August, 1903, and that said patent was approved by Nathan W. Hitchcock, Secretary of the Interior, on the fifth day of November, 1903, and that same was filed with Deaver Commission on the thirteenth day of November, 1903, and that same appears from abstract of said lot to which this affidavit is attached.

Affiant further states that on the twenty seventh day of August 1903, that he and L. C. Perryman and Jennie Perryman, wife of L. C. Perryman, executed a deed conveying away lot three in block 189, along with some other property, to F. M. Ericksten and that by and through mistake affiant's name appears as one of the grantors as H. W. Perryman when it should have been Henry W. B. Perryman, and that H. W. Perryman and Henry W. B. Perryman are one and the same persons.

Affiant further states that on the twenty third day of December 23, 1904, he, Leguist C. Perryman, Gertrude Perryman (his wife, affiant having married since the date of the above mentioned conveyances) F. M. Ericksten and Rutha Ericksten, executed a Quit Claim or Correction Deed to said above described property to W. T. K. Krich for the purpose of correcting errors in the former conveyances to said property, and that by and through mistake affiant's name appears from the abstract to which this affidavit is attached as Henry W. Perryman when it should have been Henry W. B. Perryman, and that Henry W. Perryman, as shown by said abstract and affiant are one and the same party.

Affiant further states that his correct name is Henry W. B. Perryman and that when it appears in said abstract to which this affidavit is attached as H. W. Perryman and Henry W. Perryman it is due to mistake and should have been Henry W. B. Perryman.
