That the First National Bank of Tulsa, D.T., for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar to it in hand paid by Chauncey W. Owen, the receipt whereof is hereby confessed and acknowledged, does hereby grant, sell, quit claim and release unto said Chauncey W. Owen and unto his heirs and assigns forever, the following described real estate lying in the 28th Recording District of the Indian Territory, to-wit:

Lots numbered Four and Five in Block numbered sixty in the Town of Tulsa, according to the official Plat thereof. This deed being made to release the lien of a certain Mortgage dated January 24th 1906 and filed for Record in the Eighth Recording District of the Indian Territory, on the 30th day of January 1906, by Chauncey W. Owen and Mary Owen, his wife, conveying said Real Estate to the First National Bank of Tulsa, D.T., to secure the payment of all sums due or that may become due. This being intended as a Release of said mortgage only as to the above described property.
