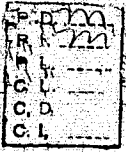

Know All Men By These Presents, That Southwestern Land & Investment Company a corporation of Muskogee Indian Territory, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar Dollars (\$1.00), to it paid by Fred Bowers the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has remised, released, sold, conveyed and by these presents does remise, release, sell, quit claim and convey unto the said Fred Bowers, his heirs and assigns, all thought, title, claim and demand the said Southwestern Land & Investment Company has in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land, lying and being situated in the Creek Nation of Western District Indian Territory, to-wit:

The South-west quarter of the North-west quarter of Section Twenty-four (24) Township Sixteen (16) North Range Fourteen (14) East, of the Indian Base and Meridian in the Indian Territory.
To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Fred Bowers his heirs and assigns forever, free and discharged from the claim of the said Southwestern Land & Investment Company or any person whomsoever, claiming unto claim the same by, through or under the said Southwestern Land & Investment Company, but none other.

In Witness Whereof, the said Southwestern Land & Investment Company, has caused its corporate name to be signed and its corporate seal, official name to be signed by the hand of its Secretary John C. McShea. This 26th day of July, 1906.
