This Indenture, made this 25th day of August A.D. 1906 between Keele's Land & Trust Company of Muskogee Indian Territory, Western District party of the first part, and George Fields of Muskogee Indian Territory, Western District party of the second part.

Witnesseth; that the said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar and other valuable considerations in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) has demised, released, sold, conveyed and quitclaimed, and by these presents do demise, release, sell and convey and quitclaim unto the said party of the second part; his heirs and assigns forever, all the right title, interest, claim and demand which said party of the first part in and to the following described lot, piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory, Western District, and hereinafter described as follows, to-wit:

The North West quarter (1/4) of the South west quarter (1/4) of section six (6) and the East half (1/2) of the North East quarter (1/4) of section eight (8) all in Township eighteen (18) North and Range thirteen (13) East.

I have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereunto belonging, or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part - of the first part, either in law or equity to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part - his heirs and assigns forever.

In Witness Whereof, - the said Keele's Land & Trust Company has caused these presents to be signed by its President and attested by its Secretary and the corporate seal to be affixed this the 25th day of August A.D. 1906.
