Quitclaim deed with relinquishment of dower.

This Indenture, Made this 28th day of August A.D. 1906 between Edward Crowell and Legus C. Perryman both widowers and residents of Tulsa Indian Territory, Western District, party of the first part, and A. B. Roberts and of Muskogee Indian Territory, Western District party of the second part.

Witnesseth, that the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar and other consideration Dollars, in hand paid by the said party of the second part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged) have devised, devised, sold, conveyed and quit claimed, and by these presents, do devise, release, sell and convey and quit claim unto the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever, all the right title, interest, claim and demand which said parties of the first part in and to the following described lot piece or parcel of land or improvements situated in the Creek Nation Indian Territory, Western District and known and described as follows to wit:

Lot six (6) in Section six (S. 6) Township Eighteen (T. 18) North. Range Thirteen (R. 13) East containing 40 acres more or less.

To have and to hold the same, together with all and singular the appurtenances and privileges thereto belonging or appertaining and all the estate, right, title, interest and claim whatever of the said part of the first part, either in law or equity, to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of the said party of the second part, his heirs and assigns forever.
