Know All Men By These Presents, That I, Grant C. Stebbins of Tulsa, Indian Territory, and in consideration of \$1.00 lawful money of the United States to me in hand paid before the execution and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have sold, assigned, transferred, and set over, and by these presents do sell, assign, transfer, and set over unto The Tulsa Fuel and Manufacturing Company of Gas, Kansas its successors and assigns all my right, title, and interest in and to a certain indenture of lease, bearing date of the 30th day of July, 1906, and made by Helen Gillis of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the first part, and Grant C. Stebbins of Tulsa, Indian Territory, party of the second part, of a certain parcel of land lying and being within the Creek Nation and described as follows, to wit: Beginning at the South West Corner of the North West Quarter of Section six (6), Township Nineteen (19) North, Range Thirteen (13) East, thence running east along the south line of said quarter section four hundred and thirty four feet, thence north westerly along the R. R. right of way to the section line, thence south one hundred and eighty feet to place of beginning,

With all and singular the premises therein described, together with the appurtenances belonging thereto, to have and to hold the same unto the said Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company its successors and assigns, and from this day and during the rest and residue and remainder of the term of years mentioned in the said indenture of lease: Subject nevertheless to the covenants, conditions and provisions therein contained. And I do hereby covenant and agree to and with the said Tulsa Fuel & Manufacturing Company that said assigned premises are free and clear of all leases, judgments, taxes, or any other encumbrances whatsoever.
