Witnesseth: That the said parties of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of One Thousand and no dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, do hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situate in Creek Nation and within the limits of the Western District Indian Territory, to wit: All interest of grantors in and to the W/2 and 3E 1/4 of 3E 1/4 of sec. Twenty four (24) in Township Eighteen (18) North of Range Fourteen (14) East

The same being 120 acres of the allotment of Ben Island, deceased,
together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereto belonging or in any
wise appertaining, and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, her heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
