General Warranty Deed.

Lewis B. Malone

This Indenture, made and entered into this 26th day of June, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between George Fields, of Tulsa, D.T. party of the first part, and Lewis B. Malone, of Tulsa, D.T. party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of Six hundred dollars, in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part the following described real estate and premises situated in Creek Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory, to-wit: All of the east half of the north east quarter of section eight (8) and the south half of the south west quarter of section six (6) except that portion that was set aside as my homestead in the above described land; - All of my right title and interest by inheritance or otherwise in and to All of the West half of the south west quarter of section five (5) and the south half of the south west quarter of section six (6) All in Township eighteen (18) North Range Thirteen (13) East, the last described tract of land being the allotment of Nellie Fields deceased, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining, the said grantor hereby covenants with the said grantee that at the making of these presents, the premises above described are free from all incumbrances and that the said George Fields, well warrant and defend the title thereto to the said grantee its Successors, and assign against the lawful claims of all persons whomsoever.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, its successors, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
