The Bureau has been unable to find any record of the name of the author of the book "The Story of the American Revolution," which was published in Boston in 1800. The title page of the book is as follows:
"The Story of the American Revolution, from its origin to the final victory over Great Britain, in 1783. By J. L. Jackson, Esq., author of 'The History of the American Revolution,' &c. Boston: Published for the Author by C. D. Merriam, 1800."
The date of publication is given as 1800, but the year of composition is given as 1783. The author is given as J. L. Jackson, Esq., and the publisher is given as C. D. Merriam.
I hope you will be able to furnish me with some additional information concerning this book, and I shall be much obliged if you will do so.
