Know all men by these presents, That I, Edward Still of Tahlequah of the Cherokee Nation, Indian Territory in consideration of Twenty five & $\frac{1}{4}$ dollars, to me paid by Albert W. Taylor of Tahlequah, I, I, the receiver hereof do hereby acknowledge, do hereby give, grant, bargain, sell and convey unto the said Albert W. Taylor and his heirs, successors and assigns, that certain tract or parcel of land situate in Cherokee Nation aforesaid, bounded and described as follows:

WW $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 23, Twp 23 N, Range 12 East, the same being the allotment filed out by Alie Bayley, deceased, together with all the improvements thereon and all the privileges and affumances thereto belonging.

To have and to hold the foregoing premises to the said Albert W. Taylor and his heirs, successors and assigns, in fee simple forever, and I, the said Edward Still for myself and my heirs, executors, and administrators, do covenant with the said Albert W. Taylor and his heirs, successors and assigns, that I am lawfully seized in fee of the aforesaid premises, that they are free from all incumbrances, that I have a good right to sell and convey the same to the said Albert W. Taylor as aforesaid, and that I will and my heirs, executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Albert W. Taylor and his heirs, successors and assigns from against all lawful claims and demands of all persons.
