This Deed was made and entered into this 24 day of July, one thousand, nine hundred and six, by and between Cook K. Still of H. Leavenworth, Kansas party of the first part, and Albert W. Taylor of Lehigh, Pa. party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first, for and in consideration of the sum of Twenty five and no/100 Dollars in hand paid the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant, bargain, sell, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described real estate and premises situate in the Cherokee Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to wit: All his right, title and interest in and to the northwest quarter of section Twenty-five (25), Township Twenty-three (23), Range Twelve (12), the same being the allotment filed on by Alice Bayles, deceased, together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging or in any wise appertaining and warrant the title to the same.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
