General Warranty Deed.

Oklahoma Land Company,

This Indenture, Made and entered into this 2nd day of August, one thousand nine hundred and six, by and between Silas B. Childers, a mixed blood person, Indian of Comanche, Del. Ter. party of the first part, and Oklahoma Land Company, of Muskogee, D. T., party of the second part.

Witnesseth: That the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One dollar & other valuable considerations Dollars in hand paid, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, does hereby grant bargain sell convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, the following described undivided and prairie situate in the Comanche Nation, and within the limits of the Indian Territory to wit: All his undivided interest in Northeast quarter of Section Three (3), Township Seventeen (17) North, Range Fourteen (14) East, being the allotment of his deceased brother Pratt Childers and all his undivided interest in the Southeast quarter of Section Three (3), Township Seventeen (17) N., Range Fourteen (14) E., being the allotment of his deceased brother Paul Childers together with all the improvements thereon, and the appurtenances and immunities thereunto belonging, with any and every appertaining and warrant title to the same.

And I, — Wife of the said — for and in consideration of the said sum of money, do hereby release and relinquish unto the said party of the second part all my right of dower and homestead in and to the said lands.

To have and to hold the said lands unto the said party of the second part, its heirs, executors, administrators and assigns forever.
