Know all Men By These Presents: That Sterling P. Mc Leray is a deceased allottee of lands in the Cheyenne Nation, and that there were allotted to him the following described lands located in the Cheyenne Nation, to-wit: The $3\frac{1}{2}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of section 12, in Township 23 North Range 12 East, and the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of said section containing 90 acres, and the $\frac{1}{2}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ and the $1\frac{1}{2}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of section 4, in Township 26 North, Range 18 East, and also the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of the $3\frac{1}{4}$ of section 12, Township 27 North, Range 17 East, all the last mentioned land being located in the Cheyenne Nation and containing 50 acres, making the total amount of land allotted to him 140 acres.

That the said Sterling Mc Leray left surviving himself as his sole heir, a mother, Jemima Mc Leray, and brothers of the whole and half blood, namely: William C. Mc Leray, John Mc Leray and David McCullough, and a sister by the name of Martha A. Miller, and another sister by the name of Elgema Roberts, and a nephew, a child of a dead brother James Mc Leray by the name of Wilton Mc Leray. That since his death the said Elgema Roberts has died, leaving as her sole heir Lickett Roberts, a child; and that the said John Mc Leray and his wife, Mamie Mc Leray, now residing in the State of Colorado, and the said William C. Mc Leray and his wife, Rebecca Jane Mc Leray, now residing in Colorado, and the said Martha A. Miller and her husband, Andrew Miller, now residing in the Indian Territory and the said David McCullough, and his wife, Bessie McCullough, now residing in the Indian Territory, and the said Jemima Mc Leray, a single woman, now residing in the Indian Territory, in consideration of the payment to them of nine hundred thirty three dollars and thirty three and one third cents (\$933.33 $\frac{1}{3}$), made by W. H. Komegay, Have Granted, Bargained, Sold and Conveyed, and by these presents do Grant, Bargain, Sell and Convey unto the said W. H. Komegay and his heirs, To Have and To Hold Forever, all their right, title and interest in and to the above described lands, allotted to the said Sterling P. Mc Leray, deceased. And they covenant with said Komegay that the said Jemima Mc Leray has a right to transfer to him a life estate, for the term of her life, in and to said lands, and that the other parties, heirs of said Sterling P. Mc Leray mentioned herein, have a right each to transfer to said Komegay an undivided one sixth ($\frac{1}{6}$) interest in and to said lands.

And the said Mamie Mc Leray wife of said John Mc Leray in consideration of said payment, hereby relinquishes unto said Komegay and his heirs all her right and possibility of dower in and to said lands.

And the said Rebecca Jane Mc Leray wife of said William C. Mc Leray in consideration of said payment, hereby relinquishes unto said Komegay and his heirs all her right and possibility of dower in and to said lands.

And the said Bessie McCullough, wife of said David McCullough, in consideration of said payment, hereby relinquishes unto said Komegay and his heirs all her right and possibility of dower in and to said lands.
