Report of Commissioners

Come now Thomas Parry, Clarence Randolph and G. W. Snoddy, who are residents of the Western District of Indian Territory, Commissioners appointed by the court in this cause on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August 1, 1906 to make a partition of the lands described in the decree in this cause, and report to the court; that in pursuance to said decree and said order of appointment they did on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of August, having first subscribed to an oath hereto attached and made a part of this report.

Most carefully viewed and having examined the land to be divided, forthwith proceeded to make partition thereof according to the decree of this court and did allot the several portions and shares thereof to the respective parties, quality and quantity being relatively considered by them according to the respective interests of the parties as adjudged by the court and did allot partition and set aside said interest as follows:
