

Now on the 25th day of August, 1906, comes the plaintiff by their attorney J. T. Schuermayer Esq; and files herein therewith of Thomas Parry, Clarence Randolph and T. W. Snoddy, Commissioners heretofore appointed by this Court to make partition of the land for which partition is prayed in this cause; and also comes defendant W. Reynolds, by H. Ross Bailey Esq, his attorney and said partition taken up by the Court for hearing, and after being by the Court fully considered, and no cause being shown why the same should not be set aside, it is by the Court ordered and decreed that the same be in all things approved and confirmed and that the partition and division as made by said Commissioners be firm and effectual forever.

It is further ordered by the Court that the following sums be allowed to the parties named and taxed as costs herein,
