Rental contract.

This agreement, made and entered into this 11 day of August, 1906, by and between John Caesar, of Muskogee,
 Okla., for himself and on behalf of himself citizens of the Creek Nation party of the first part and G. W. Roberts
 party of the second part.

Witnesseth, That for and in consideration of the covenants and agreements herein after made by the party of the
 second part, the party of the first part this day and by these presents doth demise and let to the party of the
 second part, his heirs and assigns, for agricultural purposes, for the term of Four years, from the 1st day
 of January 1907 the following described piece of land:

The Northwest quarter of the South east quarter of Section 16, Township 18 N, Range 14 E.

It is understood and agreed that the party of the second part will pay said party of the first part a rental
 of \$25⁰⁰ during the term of this contract, payable as follows:

One in advance, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged.

It is further agreed that the party of the first part shall have the privilege of using timber for fire
 wood and posts.
