Before me, the undersigned Notary Public within and for the Territory and District aforesaid personally appeared Menene Grayson to me personally well known and a member of the Creek tribe or Nation of Indians of the Indian Territory and upon oath states that she is 30 years of age and a duly enrolled and recognized citizen of the Creek tribe or Nation of Indians of the Indian Territory; that she is the mother and sole heir at law of Salanie Gray, dec'd, that the father of the said Salanie Gray, dec'd, was never recognized by me as a husband and that we were never married according to any Indian custom or United States law; that said Salanie Gray, dec'd was a duly enrolled and recognized member of the Creek Nation and has had allotted to her heirs the following described "Homestead" in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, to-wit: The North West 1/4 of the North West 1/4 of Section Thirty Two Township Eighteen North, Range Thirteen East and containing Forty acres more or less that the said Salanie Gray, dec'd died on the 3rd day of March, 1900 and left surviving her as her sole heir at law myself, the affiant herein.

I that the said Salanie Gray, dec'd, left no children surviving her born since May 20, 1901, and did not dispose of her homestead or any portion of her allotment by will or otherwise; that to my knowledge no probate or other court proceedings has been had involving title to said land and the heirs of the said deceased allottee has not been judicially determined.
