This Indenture made the 25th day of June, 1906, between Hecla Oil Company of Tulsa, Indian Territory, a corporation organized and existing under and in pursuance to an act of Congress approved February 18th, 1901, party of the first part, and Savoy Oil Company, a New Jersey corporation party of the second part,

Witnesseth: That said party of the first part, for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar (\$1.00) and other good and valuable considerations, to it paid by the party of the second part, at or before the making and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, aliened, remise, released, conveyed, and confirmed, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, alien, remise, release, convey and confirm unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns forever, all its right, title and interest of every kind, name and nature in, to, and in relation to, certain oil and gas leases, as follows:

A certain oil and gas lease dated the 28th day of July, 1905, and expiring the 27th day of July, 1920, of one hundred sixty (160) acres, being the SW 1/4 of Sec. 1, Twp. 12 N., R. 13 E., in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, taken by said party of the second part in its own name, as lessee, from Malisa Wiley, as lessor, together with all the issues, rents and profits thereof.

And a certain other lease dated the 12th day of July, 1905, and expiring the 16th day of July, 1920, of seventy-eight and nineteen one hundredths (78.19) acres, being Lots three (3) and four (4) of Sec. 6, Twp. 15 N., R. 14 E., in the Creek Nation, Indian Territory, taken by said party of the second part in its own name, as lessee, from Louise Collett, as lessor, together with all the issues, rents and profits thereof.
