This office is in receipt of a communication from the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes, enclosing a copy of a report of the appraisement of your improvements located on the land selected by John W. Perryman as his allotment.

This appraisement has been made in accordance with Section 5 of the Creek Agreement, which reads as follows:

"If any citizen have in his possession, in actual cultivation, lands in excess of what he and his wife and minor children are entitled to take, he shall, within ninety days after the ratification of this agreement, select therefrom allotments for himself and family, and if he have lawful improvements upon such excess he may dispose of the same to any other citizen, who may thereupon select lands so as to include such improvements; but, after the expiration of ninety days from the ratification of this agreement, any citizen may take lands not already selected by another; but if lands so taken be in actual cultivation, having thereon improvements belonging to another citizen, such improvements shall be valued by the appraisement committee, and the amount paid to the owner thereof by the allottee, and the same shall be a lien upon the unto and profits of the land until paid. Provided, That the owner of the improvements may remove the same if he desires."

The report of the Committee has been approved by the Commission to the Five Civilized Tribes.

The appraisement is as follows:
