Hamilton was the mortgagor in a conveyance dated January 20th, 1904 and recorded on the 8th day of March, 1904 in Book E, page 347, and who was the grantee of a deed of Release of said instrument under the name of Nellie F. Campbell dated August 6th, 1904 and Recorded August 12th, 1904 in Book L, page 6, and who as Nellie F. Campbell, was the grantor in a certain deed of property conveying to J. A. Friend, the following described property in the Town of Tulsa, D. T. to-wit:

"Beginning at N.E. corner Lot One Block One Hundred and Six in City of Tulsa, D. T., thence West 90 feet thence South 150 feet, thence East 90 feet thence North 150 feet to place of beginning. That at the time of making said Mortgage she was the wife of Thomas Campbell; that said Thomas Campbell died and that she afterwards married Charlie Hamilton from whom she was divorced prior to June, 1905; that at the time she executed said deed to J. A. Friend, she was a single woman.
